By opening "Self-Service" you should be able to download the following apps for free. This needs to be done by Monday 24th March.

- Google Drive
- iMovie

- Inspiration Maps Lite
- Tellagami

We will advise you of any apps that need to be downloaded at a later date.

If you have issues with your home internet connection you are more than welcome to use the wi-fi connection available at school to download the apps. The school wi-fi will automatically connect when you are on school grounds, so you could take a few minutes either before or after school to download these apps. We ask that you go to the either the Office or Year 4 Learning Space if you are going to do this, in order to comply with the rules of not using iPads on the playground.

It is also important that we are aware of your child's Apple ID password in case there are ever any problems that need to be resolved at school. Could you please return the slip below to school in a sealed envelope by Monday 24th March.
