# Subject Overviews



The Subject overview will give you a sense of what your children will be focusing on in class. These could be the things you talk to your child about through the term.

## Religious Education

Our topics this term are A community that celebrates God's love and My Family Loves Me. Students will begin to explore how God loves them and explore family and the love and support students experience at home. Students are invited to reflect on and celebrate the uniqueness of their families and themselves so as to appreciate that they can come to know and love God through family relationships.

Throughout the term we will continue to recite the Angelus daily.



## English

### Speaking and Listening

This term students will be involved in daily reporting tasks, GEM group tasks, cooperative tasks, structured play activities and formal speaking tasks.

### Writing and Representing

Students will engage in daily writing tasks. They will compose imaginative, informative and persuasive pieces of work on familiar topics. Students will use sight word knowledge, phonic knowledge and word bank lists when writing.

### Reading and Viewing

Students will be involved in concepts of print, phonemic awareness, listening tasks, shared reading tasks, and guided reading sessions. Focusing on the use of a variety of texts, developing and using effective reading strategies and comprehending what is read and seen.



## Mathematics

Students will be involved in tasks that allow them the opportunity to construct ideas and focus their attention on mathematical strategies. They will be involved in tasks, which allow them to use their skills in addition and subtraction as well as multiplication and division. Students will learn to identify the mass of different objects and compare them using hefting. They will manipulate, sort and describe the properties of 2D and 3D objects using everyday language.





## Science and Technology

### Weather in my World and Backyard to Bush

This unit provides opportunities for students to communicate observations and ideas about the weather. Students will draw conclusions and discover new learning about temperature and its affect on nature, animals and people. Students will also learn about the basic needs of living things. We will also be going on an excursion to the zoo on the 23<sup>rd</sup> August to further our understanding.

## Creative Arts

During our Creative Arts lessons the children will be looking at creating different celebrations, focusing on line, colour and texture. Students will also explore and appreciate portraits created by famous artists. They will reflect on similarities and differences within artists work. The children will continue to have music lessons with Mrs Laus on Tuesdays and Wednesdays.



## Personal Development, Health and Physical Education

During Personal Development and Health lessons we will focus on identifying how people grow and change. Students will have the opportunity to describe physical changes that have occurred since birth and identify their personal characteristics and abilities.

The children will continue to have PE lessons with Mr Jones. We will also have sport sessions in which we will focus on developing gross motor skills.
