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#### PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Dear Parents,

Welcome to Term 4! The first week of term is always one of excitement and happiness as we all reconnect with our friends, children, parents and teachers alike. Term 4 is also one where a variety of emotions arise as we begin to think about our transition to a new grade next year. This can cause anxiety over the unknown. It is important to acknowledge that we all feel a bit anxious when things change, but we need to remember that everything will be ok. It is useful to reflect on other times when we felt like that and how we were able to resolve our feelings. It is at these challenging times that persistence, faith in ourselves and positive thinking are very important.

This Sunday, the Gospel reading tells a parable that Jesus shared. The parable is an unusual one in that a widow is persistent in seeking justice from a judge and wears him down to make a decision. The Gospel appears to commend praying to God, with the persistence displayed by the widow in her dealing with the judge. But it hardly means to suggest that God needs to be worn down like the judge. It commends an attitude of trust in God that would motivate such persistence in prayer - even when the answer seems a long time in coming.

This concept of persistence is reflected in the life story of St Gerard Majella, whose feast day falls today. St Gerard is the patron saint of expectant mothers - a group of women who demonstrate great persistence, faith and positive thinking. St Gerard was from a poor family and at the age of twelve his father died and he was sent away to become an apprentice to his uncle. His journey brought him to the desire to become a capuchin monk. He was rejected several times, but remained true to his desire to live a religious life. He spent his life serving the poor in his community and supporting his mother.

As we commence Term 4, let us all be models of persistence, faith and kindness. I wish you all a happy and successful term.
