Dear Parents,

During the past week we have been amazed by the range of talent amongst our children. Last night the children in our school band performed a concert for their parents. As I sat back and enjoyed the concert I was impressed by the number of children who were able to confidently perform solo pieces. Many of our junior band members performed pieces with fellow band members to support each other. I even learned that Miss Margaret plays the drums!!



Last Friday we held our first Mission to Busk afternoon to support our Carmelite mission work in East Timor. There were over 60 acts performing ranging from singers, dancers, musicians, small bands, gymnasts, magicians, card tricks and even a puppet show. The children prepared these acts themselves and rehearsed with the support of their parents.

Last week Nancy Mercurio, who coordinates the fundraising for the Carmelite fathers, visited our parish and school. She spoke to our community about the projects big and small that the Carmelites have been working on. Our children were excited to see photographs of the children in Zumalai and Raimia using the sharpeners we sent them. The money we raised will support other works such as providing professional learning for teachers, supporting trainee teachers who are working at the Carmelite schools, providing scholarships for students, providing teaching resources such as sport equipment and musical instruments.

This experience has provided our children with the opportunity to live the call of mission and service to our fellow humans. These are opportunities where we can be saints.
