Dear Parents,

The first week of school has been a busy one. We have welcomed our new Kindergarten students and their families, band lessons have commenced with our Captivate Tutors and today our Year Six students headed out to Camp Collaroy.

Each year we have a theme for the year that focuses our work as a community of learners. Our 2020 theme is:

Journeying Together to Grow and Glow

This theme will form the focus for the Year Six children at camp and also at our Opening School Mass on Friday, 21 February. When developing this theme we also considered our school goals for the year. We have three key goals that we work on:

MISSING OR OVERDUE BOOKS

If your child has any class readers or library books that have been at home for a while, they are most likely overdue. Having multiple overdue books may prevent your child from borrowing and prevents other children from enjoying the books you have at home. The library is open everyday at lunchtime for students to borrow or return.

CHILDREN'S SACRAMENTAL PROGRAM

If you feel your child is ready...' The first sentence in the parish sacramental form for children invites the parents to discern their child's readiness to begin formally preparing to receive and celebrate the sacraments. In the Diocese of Parramatta, there is no maximum age that a person may begin this process, but there is a minimum. This is not meant to inconvenience parents, but to give the child some time to gradually increase their spirit of faith within a Christian community. The 2020 February School Census will take place on Friday, 7 February. To assist in the smooth and accurate completion of the School Census, please ensure that all letters of absence for Friday and any other days are sent to school via a note, email or Skoolbag with the following information...

- child's name
- date(s) absent
- reason explaining absence

This is a legal requirement.

CHILD PROTECTION

It is a system requirement for adults who volunteer in schools to complete the online 'Child Protection Training' module and attend a child protection briefing every two years. Click on the link to complete the Child Protection Module.

Please note the only two Child Protection Briefings being held this term are on February 18th at 6:15pm and February 19th at 9:15am in the Mercy Library.

SAFE DRIVING

Parents are asked to be considerate and patient during pick-up and drop-off times. At the moment there is a particular problem with gueued traffic that blocks the flow of traffic on Station Street in the afternoons. Parents are asked to follow these practices:

- 1. Keep the flow of traffic going by moving on guickly:
- 2. If you cannot park and someone is not leaving within half a minute, please continue around the block until the next available parking space;
- 3. If you plan to stay for a chat, park a little further to allow parents making a quick pick up to get in and out as soon as possible;
- 4. Park on a surrounding street and walk to the school to collect your child;
- 5. If a school bus is coming up the street behind you, keep moving unless you are parking

We understand that these times of the day are frustrating however we have to work together to ensure the safety of the children and all road users.


